

her back and began the journey back to the castle.



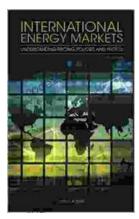
