**GILLS:** It breathes by using these organs to extract oxygen from the water.

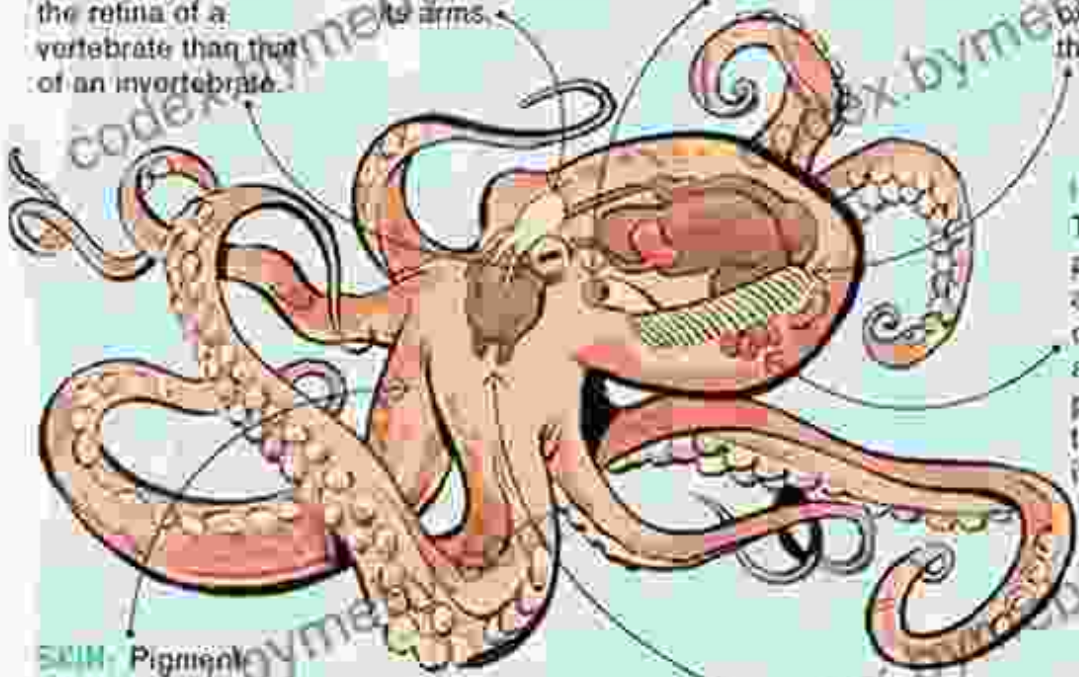
**HEARTS:** Two hearts pump blood across an octopus's gills, and a third pumps blood to the rest of its body.
