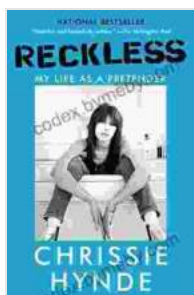


Reckless: A Journey of Hope and Discovery

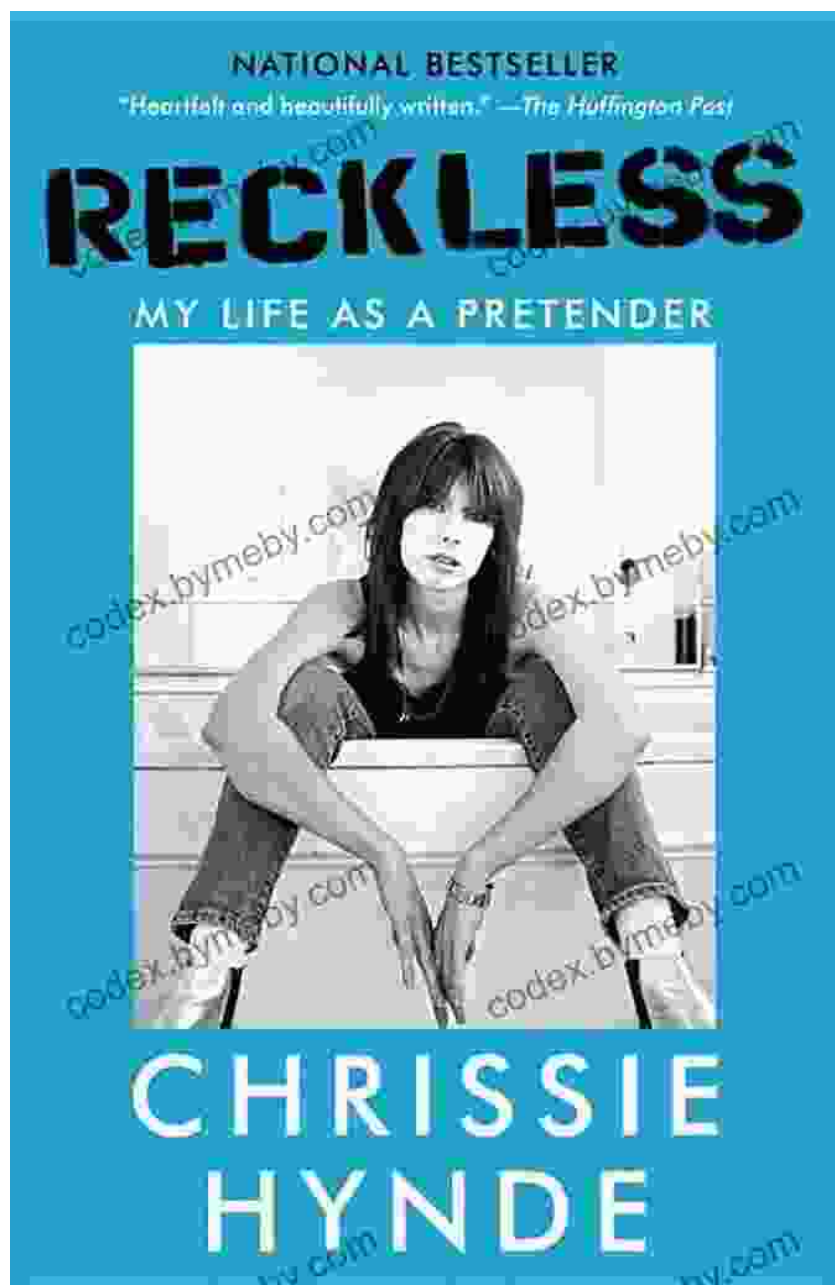
Author is a social worker and advocate for foster children. She is the founder of the non-profit organization, Hope for the Homeless, which provides support and resources to homeless youth. She is also the author
