

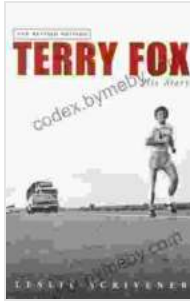

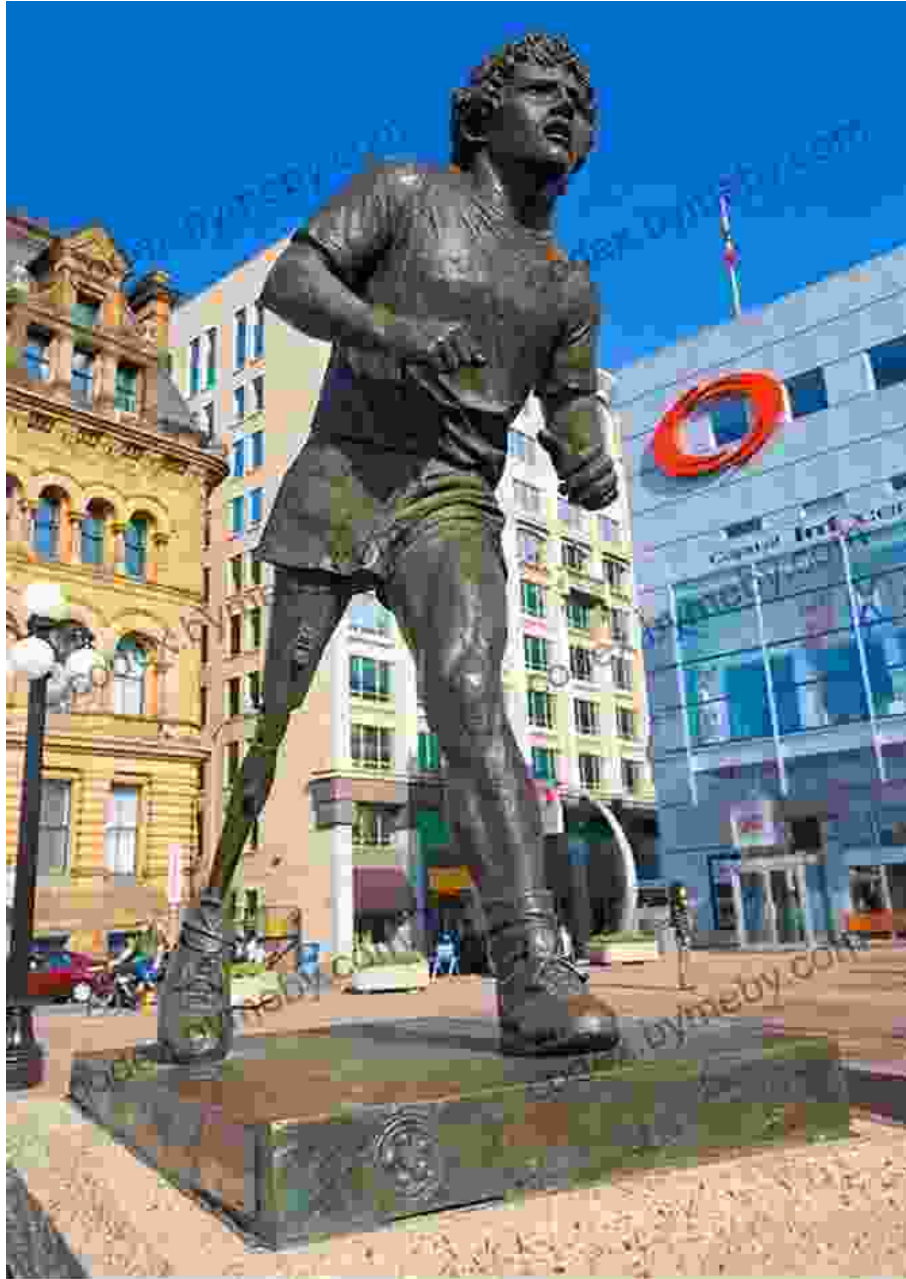

average of 42 kilometers per day. Over the next 143 days, he ran through countless towns and cities, capturing the hearts of millions of Canadians.

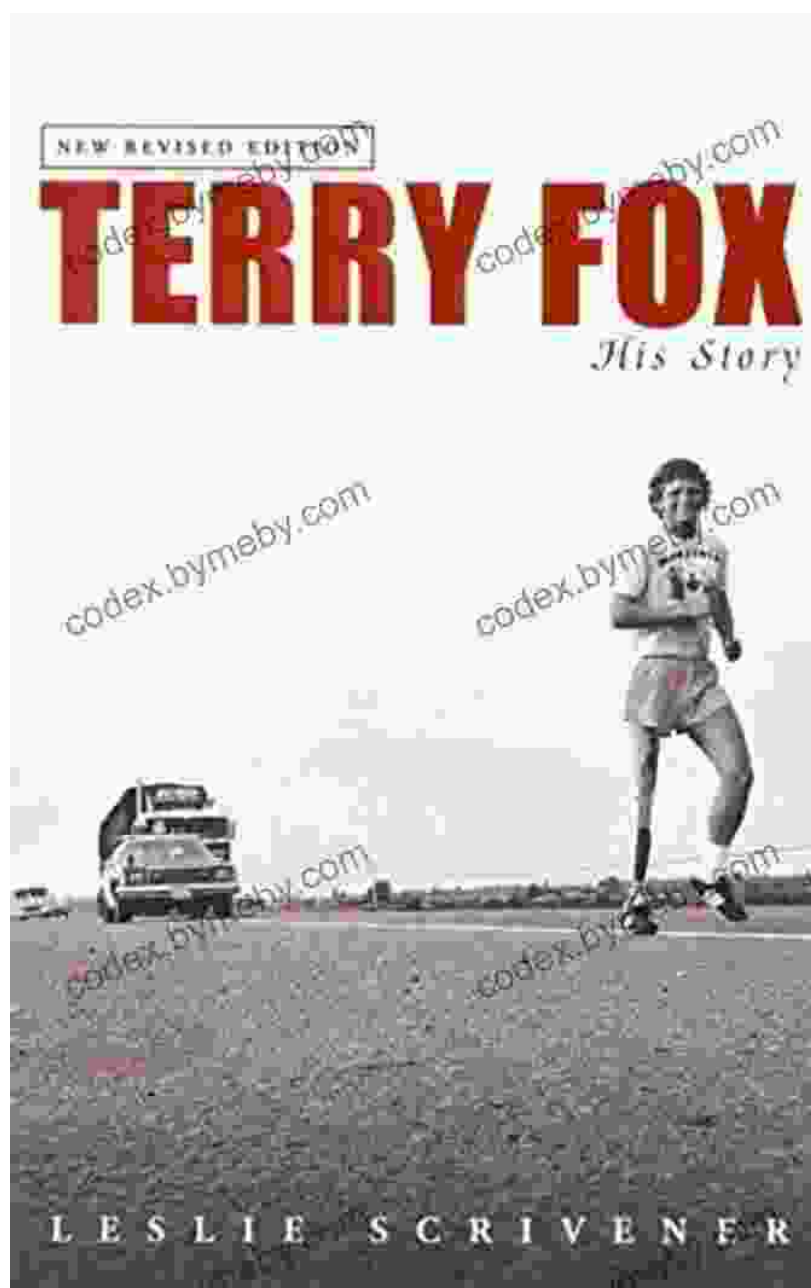
A Symbol of Courage and Hope

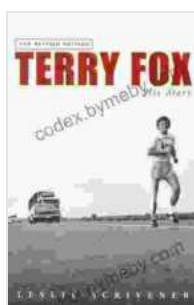
