

The Battle of Fort McHenry



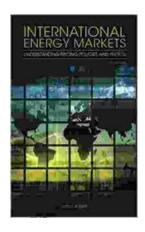
